



UNLV Policy on Private Gifts

Relationships with alumni and friends play an increasingly critical role in the future of UNLV. Our faculty, administration, coaches, and staff have front-line contact with individuals and businesses that contribute to UNLV's success.

UNLV and the NSHE Board of Regents have designated the UNLV Foundation as the lead entity in soliciting and accepting all gifts on behalf of the university. Thus, no member of the university community is authorized to enter into a solicitation or conduct fundraising activities on behalf of UNLV or any of its parts without specific authorization from the UNLV Foundation.

The UNLV Foundation complies with NSHE policy, Nevada State law, IRS, and other relevant federal regulations and provides an audited financial report to the Board of Regents annually. Additionally, the UNLV Foundation is responsible for fundraising practices, as well as acknowledging, receipting and documenting all gifts received on behalf of UNLV and for reporting on the financial activities of all other UNLV-related 501(c) 3 organizations.

The UNLV Foundation is our partner in fundraising and recognizes the importance of working with and supporting faculty, administrators, coaches, and staff with their interest in securing private support. Coordination with the UNLV Foundation is required for fundraising from individuals, corporations, and private foundations; around fundraising events such as dinners, sponsorships, auctions, golf tournaments, etc.; and in the hiring of individuals to conduct such activity on behalf of UNLV.

Invitations for participation on volunteer boards or solicitation by volunteers must be coordinated through the Director of Development in a college or unit or, in the absence of such a position, through Scott Roberts, Associate Vice President for Development at the UNLV Foundation (702-895-2816).

Naming gifts for faculty positions, programs, or facilities must be coordinated with Nancy Strouse, Senior Associate Vice President for Development and Executive Director of the UNLV Foundation (702-895-2810) or with Bill Boldt, Vice President for University Advancement (702-895-5895).
